Sub:- Restructuring of Agriculture Service Cadre.

The Agriculture extension network is mainly used in development of agriculture by aiding the farmers through transfer of technology and rendering a host of extension services at the door step of the farmers. With the introduction of various schemes like NFSM, RKVY, ATMA and for administration of subsidy under new Agriculture Policy, Government have been contemplating for restructuring and strengthening the Agriculture Service Cadre of Directorate of Agriculture & Food Production, Odisha to make the Directorate more vibrant for prompt and effective delivery of services to the farming community in order to increase the production and productivity of the agriculture sector in the State.

2. Keeping the above objectives in view, Government have been pleased to propose restructuring of the Agriculture Service cadre by fixing the total cadre strength of Odisha Agriculture Service at 1313 (one thousand three hundred & thirteen) which includes 33(Thirty three) posts as Leave/Training/Deputation Reserve posts in different foreign bodies and deployment to other Departments. These 1313 posts concurred in by Finance Department, includes creation of 377(three hundred seventy seven) new posts in different grades, in lieu of abolition of 377 (three hundred seventy seven) posts of Assistant Agriculture Officer. The details of distribution of 1313 posts of different grades & their job chart is at Annexure-I, II, III, IV, V & VI.

3. One post in the rank of Additional Director of Agriculture in the Level-15 of Pay Matrix as per ORSP Rules, 2017 shall be created to function as Director, IMAGE in addition to the existing one post of Additional Director of Agriculture in the Office of Director of Agriculture & F.P., Odisha. Thereby, the total sanctioned post in the level of Additional Director of Agriculture in the cadre shall be 2 (two).

4. That, 6(six) posts in the rank of Joint Director of Agriculture(JDA), L-I in the Level-14 of Pay Matrix as per ORSP Rules, 2017 shall be created in addition to the existing one post raising the total nos of posts to 07(seven). The distribution of seven posts of JDA, L-I is given below:-

- (i) JDA (Special Programme & Crops), O/o DA&FP(O)
- (ii) JDA (Farm & Seeds), O/o DA&FP(O)
- (iii) JDA (Plan & Commercial Crops), O/o DA&FP(O)
- (iv) JDA (Information), O/o DA&FP(O)
- (v) JDA (Plant Protection), O/o DA&FP(O)
- (vi) Agriculturist, in Agriculture & F.E. Department
- (vii) Director, OSSOPCA (Deputation)

5. The nomenclature of the post of Joint Director of Agriculture(JDA), L-II functioning in the District offices shall be redesignated as Chief District Agriculture Officer(CDAO). The CDAO shall function within the jurisdiction of the concerned district as district head.

6. That, 29(twenty nine) posts in the rank of Joint Director of Agriculture(JDA), Level-II /CDAO in the Level-13 of Pay Matrix as per ORSP Rules, 2017 shall be created in addition to the existing 04(Four) posts raising the total posts to 33(thirty three).The CDAOs shall be posted in 30 districts and 03 posts of JDA,L-II shall be in the O/o DA&FP(O). The distribution of such 33 posts of CDAO/JDA, L-II shall be as at Annexure-II.

7. That, the nomenclature of the post of Deputy Director of Agriculture(DDA) functioning in the district offices shall be redesignated as Agriculture District Officer(ADO).

8. That, 61(sixty one) posts of Agriculture District Officer(ADO)/ Deputy Director of Agriculture(DDA) in the Level-13 of Pay Matrix as per ORSP Rules, 2017 shall be created in addition to existing 41(forty one) posts raising to the total sanctioned strength 102 (one hundred two). The distribution of 102 posts of ADO/DDA shall be as per the list at Annexure-III.

9. That, the nomenclature of the post of District Agriculture Officer (DAO) shall be redesignated as Block Agriculture Officer(BAO)/Assistant Director of Agriculture (ADA).

10. That, 280(two hundred eighty) posts of Block Agriculture Officer(BAO)/Assistant Director of Agriculture (ADA) in the Level-12 of Pay Matrix as per ORSP Rules, 2017 shall be created in addition to existing 100(one hundred) posts raising to the total sanctioned strength 380 (three hundred eighty). The distribution of 380 posts of ADA shall be as per the list at Annexure-IV.

11. In lieu of the posts to be created in the different grades of Agriculture service as mentioned in the foregoing paragraphs by way of up-gradation of the post of Assistant Agriculture Officer (AAO) in the Level-10 of Pay Matrix as per ORSP Rules, 2017, the sanction strength of the post of Assistant Agriculture Officer(AAO) shall be reduced from 1166 to 789(seven hundred eighty nine) by abolition of 377 posts of AAO. The distribution of 789 posts of AAO shall be as per the list at Annexure-V.

12. This has been concurred by the Finance Department in their File No. FIN-CSI-CADRE-0001-2017 on 27.04.2017 & 29.01.2018.

13. The amendments to or formulation of the Rules regulating nomenclature and recruitment to the restructured cadre of Agriculture Service will be finalised in the prescribed manner in due course of time.

14. This will come into effect from the date of issue of this Resolution.
