

BANANA CULTIVATION (TISSUE CULTURE)

Sri Mangal singh Mundry of village Rengali, (Lahunipara block) of Sundargarh district is a successful farmer growing Tissue Culture Banana and Mango which are highly suited for the following regions. Banana is less labour intensive, gives high remuneratin.

During the year 2014-15 he planted mango in 1 ha area with help of Horticulture Department under MGNREGS scheme. In 2018-19,he went on exposure visit outside the state toJalgaon, Maharastra under MIDH by Deputy Director of Horticulture,Sundargarh. He got inspired and got the proper technique by the experts for banana cultivation with drip irrigation. After coming back from visit with the help of Horticulture department he started cultivation of Banana in an area of 0.33 ha where he got profit of around Rs.85000/-. After that he increased the area under banana cultivation. From Mango plantation he got profit of about Rs. 35000/- during 2019-20.From 1.5 ha area he got annual profit of 1.2 lakh.

Now with this success of Mangalsingh Mundry said “banana cultivation is more profitable than paddy. I invested more man power,fertilizer and time while cultivating paddy but return were less”. Farmers as well as technical staffs from other blocks and districts are continuously visiting and contacting him and us for Tissue Culture Banana Cultivation and fruit plantation.
